ANALYSIS OF STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY

Key-findings from the survey:

1. Students have expressed satisfaction regarding the syllabus completion completely (36.7%), preparedness of the teachers (60.7%) & communications with the students (56%)
2. Students have appreciated the teacher's attitude towards teaching & fairness in evaluation.
3. Teacher's preparation, communication, use of appropriate teaching-learning process, use of ICT has been rated satisfactorily in the survey.
4. The students have expressed satisfaction regarding Class & Laboratory facilities, Library facilities, Parking facilities, Canteen & Sanitation facilities.
5. The students have opined that college provides good environment for emotional growth of students.
6. Students are satisfied with teaching & implementation of learning outcome based curriculum which includes continuous evaluation & assessment of students throughout the semester.

Student Satisfaction Survey pointed-out few grey areas where the college/Teachers do have scope for enhancement in quality of education.

These are:-

1. Need Emphasis on Skill development, inclusion of seminars, workshops & field visits for subjects.
2. Active mentorship especially for Career Guidance.
3. Enhance use of ICT in teaching and equip laboratories with small instruments.
4. Need improvement in Library, Canteen and Sanitation facilities.
5. College needs to formulate a mechanism which can identify strength & weakness of students & provide them right level of challenges & help them to overcome their weakness.
