As per the directions of the Government of Punjab, the details of the reserved seats are as follows:

## Reserved Seats (In Percentage of Total Seats)

1 Scheduled Tribes/Scheduled Castes $25 \%$
2 Backward $10 \%$
Wards of Police Personnel/Ex-servicemen/Employees of Armed Forces,
3 BSF and CRPF. This category also includes those officers who died in 2\% service.
4 Sportspersons 2\%
5 Wards of teachers employed in affiliating institutions $2 \%$
Wards of victims of terrorist attacks/people with $50 \%$ disability owing
6 to action of Security Forces/Riot victims/Sikh migrants/ (The category having lost the head of their families in riots will be given preference)

Physically disabled candidates (It is mandatory to attach a disability certificate issued by the Civil Surgeon). The division of seats is thus: Blind candidates/Candidates with poor eyesight: 1\% Deaf and Dumb candidates: $1 \%$ Candidates having lost their $\operatorname{limb}(\mathrm{s}): 1 \%$

8 Sons/Daughters and Grandsons/Granddaughters of freedom fighters

9 Candidates from families affected/displaced by tsunami

## Additional Seats per course (Not more than 4 seats for any Course/Class)

10 Seats for Single Girl Child or 1 Out of 2 Girl Children (Maximum)
2 per U
11 Seat for Cancer, AIDS and Thalassemia Patients
1 each
12 Seats for Rural Area Students 2

13 Seat for Border Area Student
Candidates who excelled and ojt performed in Youth Festivals (Vide University Letter No. PU/DYW/1010-1200 Dated 27.05.2016)

Wards of martyrs/permanent disabled (upto $80 \%$ leading of incapacitation) of Kargil War who have a valid certificate from the Ministry of Defence to this effect and the same be entered in the Pension Book of the family.
