Analysis of Student Satisfaction Survey

❖ **It is analyzed from the Survey responses that obtained from the Students pertaining to their view point regarding Teaching Learning process and various facilities offered :**

1. Majority of students expressed satisfaction regarding the syllabus completion in the class and communication skills of the teacher.
2. Students are of the opinion that teachers prepare well for their lectures in class and they use various examples and illustrations to make their point clear.
3. Students involvement in teaching learning process have been rated satisfactorily in the survey.
4. Majority of students agree that teachers assign them challenging tasks by identifying their strengths and help them to overcome their weakness if any.
5. The students have expressed satisfaction regarding class and laboratory facilities, library facilities, parking facilities, canteen and sanitation facilities.
6. Students are satisfied with internal evaluation process of the college which is fair and completely transparent.
7. Students agree that college provides good environment for their personal growth.
8. Use of appropriate teaching – learning process by the teachers has been rated satisfactorily in the survey.

❖ **Student Satisfaction Survey pointed out certain grey areas, where college/ teachers do have scope for enhancement in quality of education. These are :**

1. There is need of some improvement in Library, Canteen & Sanitation facilities.
2. Enhance use of ICT in teaching & equip laboratories with small instruments.
3. There is need of some improvement in counselling and guidance service to students.
4. Need emphasis on skill development, inclusion of seminars, workshops & field visits for subjects.
5. Students involvement in teaching–learning process should be encouraged further.
